

## **NIKKEI ASIA PRIZES 2019**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- The Nikkei Asia Prizes <u>recognize outstanding achievements by</u>
   <u>Asian individuals and organisations that contribute to the</u>
   <u>region's sustainable development and to the creation of a</u>
   <u>better future for Asia.</u>
- The Prizes <u>serve to promote mutual understanding among</u>
   <u>Asian countries and to help people around the world deepen</u>

   <u>their understanding of Asia.</u>



## **NIKKEI ASIA PRIZES 2019**

**Award Categories: Guidelines** 

#### a) **Economic and Business Innovation**

- Recognizes business and economic initiatives that improve living standards and stability in the region.
- Nominees may include:
  - 1) Entrepreneurs who have successfully developed industries and businesses with innovative business approach.
  - 2) Policy planners who have successfully undertaken important work on economic reform and/or integration of economies in the region.
  - 3) Individuals who have undertaken initiatives to eradicate poverty and/ or responded affectively to social needs.

#### b) Science and Technology

- Recognizes scientific researches and technological innovations in various fields. Eg: Bio, genome, information technology, medicine.
- Nominees may include:
  - 1) Researchers who have discovered new ways to protect the environment or recycle resources.
  - 2) Researchers who have developed new species that increase harvests.
  - 3) Medical doctors or scientists whose achievements benefit people in the region or in a country.

#### c) Culture and Community

- Recognizes people who have made a difference through cultural, artistic, or educational activities.
- Nominees may include:
  - 1) Artists, writers, craftsmen, festival organisers, leaders of projects to preserve and study historical heritage and coordinators of cultural activities in the region.
  - 2) Individuals or groups that provide indirect support for creative cultural activities and have great social impact are eligible.

\*those who do not expressly fall under the guidelines may also be nominated if their achievements benefit people in the region and are deemed to fall within one of the three categories.

#### **OTHER GUIDELINES**

#### The Prizes aims to award

- outstanding achievements and contributions which were carried out within the past single decade;
- not only individuals that have already received recognition, but also those who are not so well known, but have conducted steady and sincere activities toward creating stable lives for people, contributing to prosperity;
- those who are active at present. Nominations of young people are welcome, if their work have received certain amount of recognition.

## **WINNERS**

- Winners (recipients) may be an individual, group or organisation in Asia, excluding Japan. <u>Japanese</u> individuals, groups or organisations are <u>not eligible</u>.
- They must be of <u>Asian origin and reside in an Asian</u> country/territory for at least six (6) months every year.
- <u>"Asia"</u> includes East Asia (Northeast Asia and Southeast Asia), South Asia, as well as independent nations in the Pacific region, <u>excluding</u> Australia and New Zealand.

## **NOMINATIONS**

- Nominations from specialists in the award categories who know of worthy candidates.
- Japanese individuals/groups/organizations may submit nominations.
- Self-nominations are not accepted.
- Names of nominators will be kept confidential.

#### **NOMINATIONS**

- Nominators are required to fill in the nomination form attached
- Please include curriculum vitae and all supporting documents (relevant articles about the nominee, any academic papers written by the nominee, or a brochure of the group or organisation, etc.) together with the form and submit to <a href="mailto:wani@akademisains.gov.my">wani@akademisains.gov.my</a>

#### **SELECTIONS**

 Nominee's contributions to the region's sustainable development and to the creation of a better future for Asia.

 Consideration will also be given to the originality, impact and newsworthiness of each nominee's achievements.

## **PRIZE**

 Three million yen as well as an award certificate.

 Winners are invited and obliged to attend the award ceremony which will be held in **Tokyo** in May.
